# INIF Nail World Cup "All French Extension"

## Competition Rules

Competitive Time	2.5 hours (150 minutes)
Specification	These three different techniques are performed and all fingers are finished in the French Manicure-Style. "Acrylic Sculpture" (Both hands: Thumbs and Forefingers) "Gel Tip Overlay" (Left hand: Mid, annular, little fingers) "Acrylic Tip Overlay" (Right hand: Mid, annular, little fingers)

### Specific Rules

1. NO pre-extension allowed.
2. Preparation is allowed.
3. The length of Free edge is about 1cm (=1/2.5 inch).
4. Cut style is Square.
5. NO base coat, ridge filler, top coat allowed.
6. NO oil allowed.
7. Buffer is allowed, but NO chamois buffer allowed. Competitors must finish in gel on gel finished nail.
8. NO glue allowed in the acrylic sculpture.
9. NO drill allowed.
10. The color of tip is white. Preparation of tips is smile line, C-curve ONLY.
11. Materials used for gel are polymerized gel, white, pink clear or clear color.
12. Materials used for acrylic tip overlay and acrylic sculpture are chemical polymerization only. Colors of powder should be clear, clear pink, and white.
13. Collection is allowed ONLY during the competitive time. Colors of virtual should be natural.
14. NO C-curve clip allowed.
15. NO temperature control adjuster (e.g. pocket warmer) allowed.

## Judging Information

### Technical Judgment

1. Basic shape of extension (e.g. High point, C-curve, length, thickness, cut style, smoothness of joint and Smile line)
2. Equality in shape of three different extensions.

### Pre-judgment

1. Materials and condition of nails.
- \*You could use the light if noted on the application form.  
\*You have to declare the watt of UV light on the application form.

### Deduction of points

1. Not adhering to the rules.
2. Take things from personal belongings without permission.
3. Bad-mannered.

### Disqualification

1. Exceeding technical time.
2. Continuing to work on model after competition.
3. Injuring model.
4. Mistaking finger.
